This student must have been an active participant of the N*Light*N Youth choir at Broad Street United Methodist Church for at least one choir year.
- 2. Scholarship funds will be awarded for the 2023-2024 school year. The amount will depend upon funds available. The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution. More than one scholarship may be awarded, if funds allow.
- 3. High school graduating seniors must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or better and be in good standing with his or her high school.
- 4. Scholarship applications will be available to graduating seniors who have been a member of N*Light*N for at least one choir year. He or she does not have to be a member of Broad Street to be considered.
- 5. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and make a decision to award the scholarship.
- 6. Active participation in N*Light*N as well as other Broad Street UMC and community activities will be considered in awarding this scholarship. Other criteria include need, academic achievement, leadership qualities, as well as a desire to further their education.
- 7. All application materials (including application form, one letter of recommendation, short essay, and copy of high school transcript) for the scholarship must be submitted by **April 16. 2023.**
